

SPONSORING MEMBERSHIP

1. Sponsoring members

Sponsoring members are non-profit educational institutions which offer education or training or professional development leading to a qualification relevant, in at least some areas, to employment in the digital economy, and institutions at the periphery of the digital economy.

2. Subscription and its calculation

In general sponsoring members are obliged to pay subscriptions. Only publicly funded educational institutions (universities and polytechnics) are exempt from the obligation to pay subscriptions.

3. Restrictions on the work of organisational bodies

Sponsoring members have no right to vote or stand in the election of the head of an organisational body.

4. Voting rights at a members' meeting

Sponsoring members, in common with special members and honorary members, have a right to speak, make applications, and submit proposals, however, have no voting right.

5. Restriction of service portfolio

Sponsoring members can enjoy all special conditions, with the exception of free copies of the professional journal.
